## **Interventional Radiology service available at Wockhardt Hospital now**

Human life is getting more and more relaxed due to newer inventions in medical science. But we get very frightened when we hear the name of surgery. It also sends chill down our spine. So, we are always inclined towards simple and easy medical treatment and Interventional Radiology (IR) is one such treatment.

IR treatment is becoming more and more important in medical field due to its increasing benefits and its simplicity. This innovative medical system is available only in Mumbai, New Delhi and Trivendrum in our country. Use of this medical treatment is also done on a smaller scale in Pune, Nagpur and Nashik too.

Now this Interventional Radiology system is also being introduced at Wockhardt Hospital here. Proponent of this system, Dr. Srikant Kothekar of Wockhardt Hospital will himself do this treatment on patients there now. This information was given by Dr. Kothekar at the e-press

briefing, yesterday. Manager of Wockhardt Hospital, Nashik branch, Dr. Rakesh Sharma, Dr. Rajesh Javle, Marketing Department Head and Dr. Santosh Yadav were also present at the media briefing.

Dr. Kothekar further said that radiology imaging is normally used for making diagnosis of the diseases for example ex-ray, ultrasound. But, this faculty has advanced further and taken its next step during the last some years. One such technology has been developed with the help of imaging control, so that now it has become possible to do treatment on those ailments on which treatment was not possible earlier or where surgery was the only option. This technology is called 'Science of Interventional Imaging'. Now it has become possible to do treatment on the diseases related with blood veins, lungs and brain through this surgery.

Dr. Kothekar will be available on the first Sunday of each month at the Wockhardt Hospital here to do this treatment.
